Bright medium yellow straw color. Bright, toasty aromas and flavors of peach cobbler a la mode, coconut macaroon, and lemon blossoms with a silky, lively, dry-yet-fruity medium-full body and a warming, complex, medium-length dried apricot, spiced comice pear, Crenshaw melon, crème brulee with chewy, dusty tannins. A nice tangy, table-friendly viognier.

Emerald straw color. Delicate, nutty aromas of lemon creme brulee and praline with a supple, vibrant, dry-yet-fruity medium body and a sleek, intriguing, medium-length yellow apple, vanilla cream, and spice finish with silky tannins and moderate oak. A very smooth and tasty white wine.

A juicy, refreshing lighter-styled red with bright flavors and acidity.
